Len has been involved with Baseball Regina as a volunteer Coach, Manager through out his son's playing career.

Len took on the project of replacing 10 dugouts at Columbus park over the last two years. He acted as the general contractor and also did a lot of the construction on his own.

He coordinated efforts between Tymark construction (demolition), Loraas Disposal (disposal), Cindercrete (concrete pads), Fries Tallman Lumber (material and facility to construct frames for the dugouts), Regina Trades and Skills (construction of dugouts) and Campus Regina (welding and repairs)

We are estimating Len's time on the Dugout project to be between 300 to 350 hours. Without Len's expertise, knowledge and time it would have taken the board between 2-3 years to complete the project that Len completed in one year. Through Len's efforts and contacts he was able to get some of the materials, labour and equipment donated to help us complete the project.

As volunteer board, it is people like Len that makes our involvement easier and allows the board to concentrate on running the league and grow the game of baseball in Regina and area.

What Len has done has been very visible to our membership which in turn helps us promote and sell our raffle tickets which in turn will help us do future capital improvements to our diamonds.
